Kevin Ewing, president of the Verona Chamber of Commerce, has asked that the following request for volunteers he received from the RCAC be posted for all Verona residents. The message reads:

Kevin,

Thanks for presenting this info at your chamber meeting. We currently deliver 65 – 75 meals Mon – Fri in Oakmont, Verona, Cheswick and Springdale. There are about 14 clients (including 2 houses with couples) in Verona, mainly on the hilltop. Meals are packed and ready to go at 11am. The ideal way to deliver is with 2 people (driver and runner) and it takes about 1 hour. Not only are you delivering a meal, but sometimes you are the only contact that client has all day. Several Oakmont churches & businesses have agreed to the same day each month (2nd Tues or 3rd Fri, etc.); Sr. Lynn at St Joe's takes the 7th grade students twice a month to deliver in Verona.
